| Mumbai, Dec 23: After 25 years, a Palghar man was let off from a case of cheating wherein a woman had alleged that he had a sexual relationship with her on the pretext of marrying her. <br> The Bombay High Court acquitted the man, saying that since there was no "evidence to prove that the woman had consented to physical relationship on a misconception of fact...the mere refusal to marry would not constitute an offence under Section 417 of the IPC" $^{\prime \prime}$. <br> The woman had lodged an FIR in 1996, alleging that the accused had a sexual relationship with her on the pretext of marriage. He subsequently declined to marry her, the woman alleged in the FIR. <br> Based on the FIR lodged by the woman, a case was registered against the accused for offences punishable under Sections 376 (rape) and 417 (cheating) of the Indian Penal Code. <br> During the trial, the accused denied all the allegations levelled against him. <br> After three years of trial, the additional Sessions judge in Palghar held the accused guilty of offences punishable under Section 417 of the IPC.
