However, the question that needs to be addressed is what about the commercialisation of medical education which has accelerated and needs to be checked. <br> At the same time, while it's encouraging that medical seats have risen, these continue to be meagre compared to the increasing number of students opting for the profession. <br> The steps taken to increase the number of medical seats, as per the government, include a cen-trally-sponsored scheme for establishment of new medical colleges by upgrading district/referral hospitals, under which 157 new medical colleges have been approved and 71 are already functrally sponsored scheme for strengthening or upgradation of existing State or Central government medical colleges to increase the MBBS and PG seats, and a central sector scheme for upgradation of government medical colleges by construction of super specialty |
