Open drains death trap for Balimela residents


POST NEWS NETWORK Malkangiri, July 12: Pedestrians
of Balimela in Malkangiridistrict face a constant threat of falling into open drains, thanks to a num-
ber of drains left uncovered in the area. At least $80 \%$ of the drains are area. At least $80 \%$ of the drains are
uncovered in Balimela area alone, thereby putting the lives of many
including the elderly, kisd and domestic animals in risk.
On many roads, drains as deep On many roads, drains as deep
as 5 feet remain open as slabs are either absent or damaged. It is atleged that pedestriians and cattle
often fall into the drains and get inoften fall into the drains and get injured, but the civic body does not
consider it an issue serious enough to merit its attention. The au-
thorities seem to be waiting for some tragic accident to occur be-
fore looking into the matter. Things worsen during the rainy season as the drains are filled with
