## IIT study finds link between fatty liver, diabetes

cent survs show that 40 per cent of adults suffer from it, according to the team, adding that NAFLD
is often associated with type 2 diabetes, with nearly 50 million adults
having both diseases.

NAFLD is an independent predictor of insulin resistance and
type 2 diabetes. "However, how NAFLD affects
