A dignified, dependable figure who reigned longer than any other British monarch, Elizabeth II helped steer the institution into the modern world, stripping away court rituals and making it somewhat more open and accessible

rince Charles, 73, who had been heir to the crown
for 70 years - the longest in the country's history --
has ascended the British throne The development followed immediately upon his mother Queen Elizabeth II, 96 , passed away after being monarch
since 1952 - which surpassed Queen Victoria's 63 -year reign. Victoria ruled up to 1901
