No proposal from state for HC benches: Rijiju

- High Court benches are established in accordance made by Jaswant Singh Commission and Supreme Court's judgements POST NEWS NETWORK
Bhubaneswar, Dec 9: Odisha government has not yet submitted adetailed proposal for establishment of benches of Orissa High Court
including its location in consultation with the HC.
This was informed by Union
Law and Justice Minister Kiren Law and Justice Minister Kiren Rijiju in a written reply to a ques-
tion posed by Koraput MP (Congress) Saptagiri Sankarar Ulaka in Lok Sabha Friday.
Rijiju said requests for establishment of High Court benches in
places other than the principal places other than the principal
seat of HCs have been received from various organisations from time to time including the government of Odisha.
The Odisha government has requested for setting up of High Court bench in western and southern region of the state, he said.
"The Central govenment has requested the state government has of posed benches including its location in consultation with the High
Court of Orissa. However, no re-

sponse has been received yet," said
the Law Minister. Atpresent, no complete proposal from the Odisha government re-
garding setting up of abench of the HC is pending with the Centre, he
clarified clarified.

said the benches are established in accordance with the recommendations made by the Jaswant Singh Commission and judgement pro-

The number of Indians who re nounced their citizenship was $1,33,049$ in 2017 , and five years later till October 31, this year a total of 1,83,741 gave up their citizenship.

vertisements which distracted him. The apex court slapped a cost ₹ $₹ 55,000$ on a petitioner who had
sought compensation of 775 lakh
from Google India for the advertisements shown on YouThube which allegedly had explicit content. court termed as "atrocious" the petition filed by a Madhya Pradesh esident who claimed that due to he advertisements, his attention clear a competitive examination. Google-owned firm, YouTube, is a video hosting platform.
"You want damages because yo "You want damages because you and yourtay because of that your attention was diverted, and you could not clear the exam?"' a bench asked the petitioner, who was appearing in person. "It is one of the most atrocious

watch the advertisements is his prerogative."

gised to the court and sought to withdraw the petition. The bench said he can't come just to the court and file such petitions only for publicity.
