## NICKNAMED SWOT, THE SATELLITE IS NEEDED MORE THAN EVER AS CLIMATE CHANGE WORSENS DROUGHTS, FLOODING AND COASTAL EROSION

satellite that will map almostall of
the world's oceans, lakes and rivers
rocketed into orbit Friday.
The predawn launch aboard a
SpaceX rocket from Vandenberg
Space FFrece Base in California
capped a highly successful year
for NAAA.
Nicknamed SWoT - short for
Surface Water and Ocean
Topography - the satellite is needed
more than ever as climatechange
worsens droughtc, flooding and
coastal erosion, according to sci-
entists,
"Were going to be able to see

water is at any given time," said


Benjamin Hamlington at NASA's
Jet Propulsion Laboratory in $\quad \begin{gathered}\text { Pasadena, California. } \\ \text { About the size of an SUV, the }\end{gathered}$
satellite will measure the height of
water on more than Earth's murface than 90 per cent of Earth's surface, allowing scien-
tists to track the flow and identify tists to track the flow and identify
potential high-risk areas. It will potential high-risk areas. It wil
also survey millions of lakes as well as 1.3 million miles ( 2.1 million kilometres) of rivers, from headwater to mouth.
The satellite will shoot radar pulses at Earth, with the signals
bouncing back to be received by a pair of antennas, one on each end of a 33 -foot ( 10 -metre) boom. currents and eddies less than 13 miles (21 kilometres) across, as well as areas of the ocean where
water masses of varying temper water masses of varying temper-
atures merge. NASA's current fleet of nearly 30
Earth-observing NASAScurrent fleet of nearly 30
Earth-observing satellites cannot
make out such slight features. And
while these older satellites can map the extent of lakes and rivers, their measurements are not as deCarolina's Tamlin Pavelsky, who is part of the mission. Perhaps most importantly, the
satellite will reveal the satellite will reveal the location the shift of coastlines, key to saving lives and property. It will cover the globe between the Arctic and Antarctica at least once every three
weeks, as it orbits more than 550 miles (890 kilometres) high. The mission is expected to last three
years. NASA and the French Space NASA and the French Space
Agency collaborated on the USD 1.2
billion project with Britain and bilion project, with
Canada chipping in.

"purpose of establishing identity" on a "voluntary basis,", Law Minister Kiren Rijiju said in Lok Sabha. He was responding to a question
on electoral rolls. The Election electoral rolls. The Election gramme to collect the Aadhaar
number of existing and prospective electors on a voluntary basis from August 1 in all the states and UTs.
It is voluntary to link Aadhaar with a Voter ID and consent is obtained from the elector for Aadhaar authentication in Form 6B which was recently introduced, he said.
However, the minister made it However, the minister made it for withdrawing the consent" to share Aadhaar details.
Asked whether the name of the
voters whose voter ID linked whose voter IDs are nothaar will be struck off from the voters' list, he replied in the negative.
The minister informed the Rajya Sabha Thursday that more than 54 ers have opted to link their Aadhaar details with the voter list.
