Some of the banned drugs are loramphenicol, nitrofluorene nd the additives under them like razolidone, furaltadone, furiluramide, nitrofurantoin, nifutel, nifurozyme and several other tibiotics and chemicals. nipulation brought his eponymous business empire to its knees. With his

lethal. In early February, Moody's downgraded the ratings outlook for sevthe conglomerate's troubles. And the rout continued even after the group a billion ahead of schedule, halving its revenue growth targets, and holding Mod planned capita expenditures. Mod himser has remained silent, even as the country's opposition par"strong" regulatory agencies would deal with this scandal, though their per formance so far has been dismal. The Securities and Exchange Board of India accused of acting as a "silent operator" by several legislators, has issued
