## Not in line with Indian ethos, Centre tells SC

- Non-heterosexual forms of marriages or unions though not recognised are not unlawful, says the govt agencies
New Delhi, March 12: The Central government has told the Supreme
Court that living together as part ners and having sexual relationship by same sex individuals, which is decriminalised now, is not com
parable with the Indian family unit-- a husband, a wife, and children born out of the union - while opposing pleas seeking recogni It on same-sex marriage. riage is not in conformity with societal morality and Indian ethos. In an affidavit, the Central government said the notion of marevitably presupposes a union

between two persons of the opposite sex. This definition is socially,
culturally, and legally ingrained into the very idea and concept of marriage and ought not to be dis-
turbed or diluted by judicial inturbed or diluted by judicial in-
terpretation, it added. The affidavit said the institution of marriage and the family are important social institutions in India that provide for the security,
support and companionship of the members of our society and bear an important role in the rearing of children and their mental and psychological upbringing also.
The Centre stressed that despit the decriminalisation of Section 377
of the Indian Penal Code, the pe-
titioners cannot claim a fundatitioners cannot claim a funda
mental right for same-sex mar riage to be recognised under the laws of the country The affidavit said that consid erations of societal morality are re
evant in considering the validity of the legislature and further, that it is for the legislature to judge and
enforce euch societal morality and enforce such societal morality and

Indian ethos. The Centre said that marriage between a biological man and a aiological womans takes place

entire political class in Tunisia has been somewhat discredited for their failure to deal wh he country's economic problems. The country has been grap pling with a string of economic crises for the past few years and the miseries
have been compounded by the pandemic and the Russian invasion of Ukraine. The current inflation of around $10 \%$ could also rise further in the coming
months due to higher taxes, lower food and energy subsidies, and the halted funding by the International Monetary Fund (IMF). The situation is tailor-made for the rise of the dictator. If Saied succeeds
in his attempt to shackle his detractors and muzze the voice of protest it would be a sad end of Tunisia's tryst with destiny and a dangerous tren

 What is slowly becoming clear to biochemists is that these sugars play as
vital a role in making the cell work as do the proteins. They conbine to form viala mole in makies such as cerbohydrates and cellulose; they are already orm known to regulate hormones, organise embryonic development, direct
movement of cells and proteins throughout the body, and regulate the immune system. It shows yet again that the DNA in the genome is only one
aspect of the complex mechanism that keeps the body running - decoding the DNA is one step towards understanding but by itself it doesn't speciify everything that happens within the organism. The ending -omics is etymologically odd, since it doesn't have a direct ancestor in the classical
languages. It's actually -ics, for a branch of knowledge, added to -ome (as in languages. It's actually -ics, for a branch of knowledge, added to -ome "as genome doesn't use it. That word was created as a blend of gene and chromosome, so the ending is actually the last part of -some, which derives
from Greek soma, body. The prefix part of glycomics is from Greek glukus, sweet. This ending hady nothing to do with -nomics, which turns up in terms economics and ergonomics. Scientists are saying that glycomics could fuel revolution in biology to rival that of the human genome (New Scientist, Oct.
2002).
