Group (PVTG) of Odisha, is
awaiting its place in the 8th
Schedule.
Odisha has the third highest
tribal population in the coun-
try and is home to 62 types of
Scheduled Tribe communities,
of which 13 are of PVTGs. The
Soura tribe is one of them and
they reside mainly in the dis-
tricts of Rayagada, Gajapatiand
Koraput. They are also present
in Srikakulam, Vizianagaram
and Visakhapatnam districts of
Andhra Pradesh.

community leaders, the indige-
nous language is being used by
the community from one gen-
