bers of the respondent (husbers of the respondent (hus-
band) which are found to be false, is an act of extreme cruelty for which there can be no condonation," the high court said.
It noted that estranged couple have barely been able to live together for about 13 months and have not been able to sustain
their matrimonial relationshin "For a couple to be deprived of each other's company and conjugal relationship is an extreme act of cruelty as has also been en-
dorsed by the apex court," the dorsed by the

of depression or stress among the

the city police has urged the
mess workers and tiffin providers
to report if a student is repeti-
tively absent from the mess and
skipping meaals or anyone's tif-

"We have launched acampaign

we are encouraging wardens to
make it a routine to knock on
each students' door at around
11pm, ask them if they are okay,
notice their activities, and keep
