JAPAN JOINS LUNAR RACE

Tokyo, Sept 7: Japan launched its lunar exploration spacecraft H-IIA rocket, clearing a path to become the world's fifth country
to land on the Moon early next year.
Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) said the rocket took off from Tanegashima Space
Center in southern Japan as planned and successfully reInvestigating Moon (SLIM). Unfavourable weather led to
three postponements in a week last month.
Dubbed the 'moon sniper',
Japan aims to land SLIM within 100 metres of its target site on the lunar surface. The $\$ 100$-million
mission is expected to reach the Moon by February.
The launch comes two weeks
after India became the fourth after India became the fourth nation to successfully land a
spacecraft on the Moon with its Chandrayaan-3 mission to the
unexplored lunar south pole. unexplored lunar south pole.
