riety of fields. "In microreactors,
droplets can be used to create e dif.
ferent reaction environments or
mix different chemicals. In drug
delivery systems, droplets can be
used to deliver drugs or other
agents to specific tissues or or-
gans. In crystallisation studies,
droplets can be used to control
the growth of crystals.
"And in cell culture platforms,
droplets can be used to grow cells
in a controlled environment, which
can help to improve cell viabil-
ity and proliferation,", explains
lead researcher Rutvik Lathia,
PhD student at the Centre for
Nano Science and Engineering
(CeNSE), IISc. However, there are
several challenges in using such
droplets, the release said.
They are vulnerable to con-
tamination from the ambient en-
vironment, the ease and success
